
## CSS

- Cascading Style Sheets (CSS) exist to style your HTML - to present your content.
- The language of CSS is somewhat different to HTML but it remains simple and straightforward.
- Selector(s) {property:value;}

## CSS Versions

- CSS1
- CSS2
- CSS3
- Unlike HTML versions which need to be specified to the browser in order to read the file correctly, CSS syntax (the way CSS is written) has remained exactly the same throughout all the versions. This means if you write in CSS1, it should also be completely valid CSS2 and CSS3. The only real differences between the versions are different properties and selectors
